- Constructed a backend framework complete with User Auth utilizing Bcrypt to avoid storing plain text passwords and guard against rainbow token attacks.
- Incorporated user friendly UI complete with forms that interact with mouseover using JavaScript event listeners and css transitions.
- Built out full CRUD for users, breweries, beers, and reviews storing related images via the use of Active Storage.

- Designed and stylized a frontend UI/UX utilizing CSS Media Queries, Flex-Box, and Pseudo-selectors to create a more responsive application.
- Employed and leveraged the Yelp API to seed a backend database using MongoDB, Express.js and Node.js, sending information to the frontend via custom controllers and http.
